Kickoff vs. Kinder

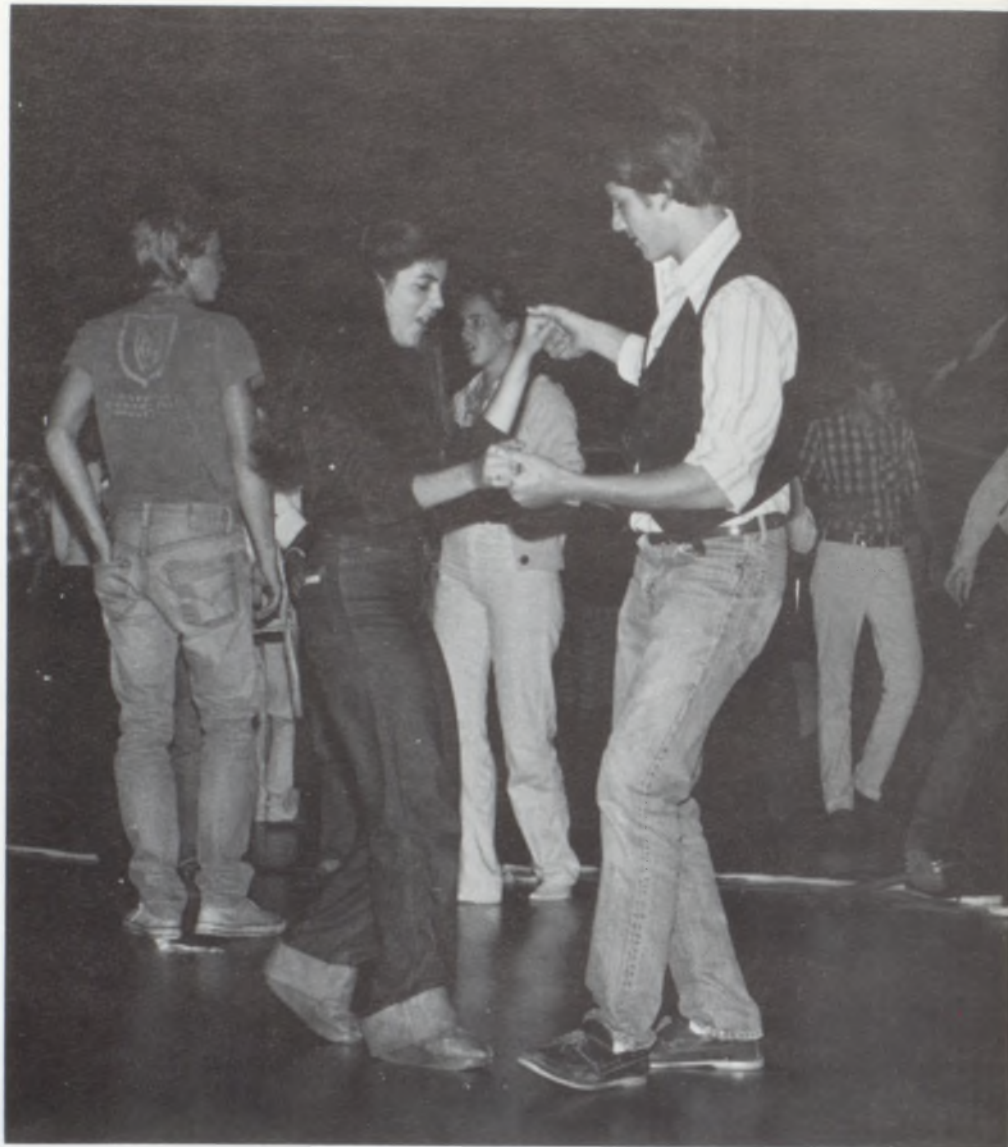

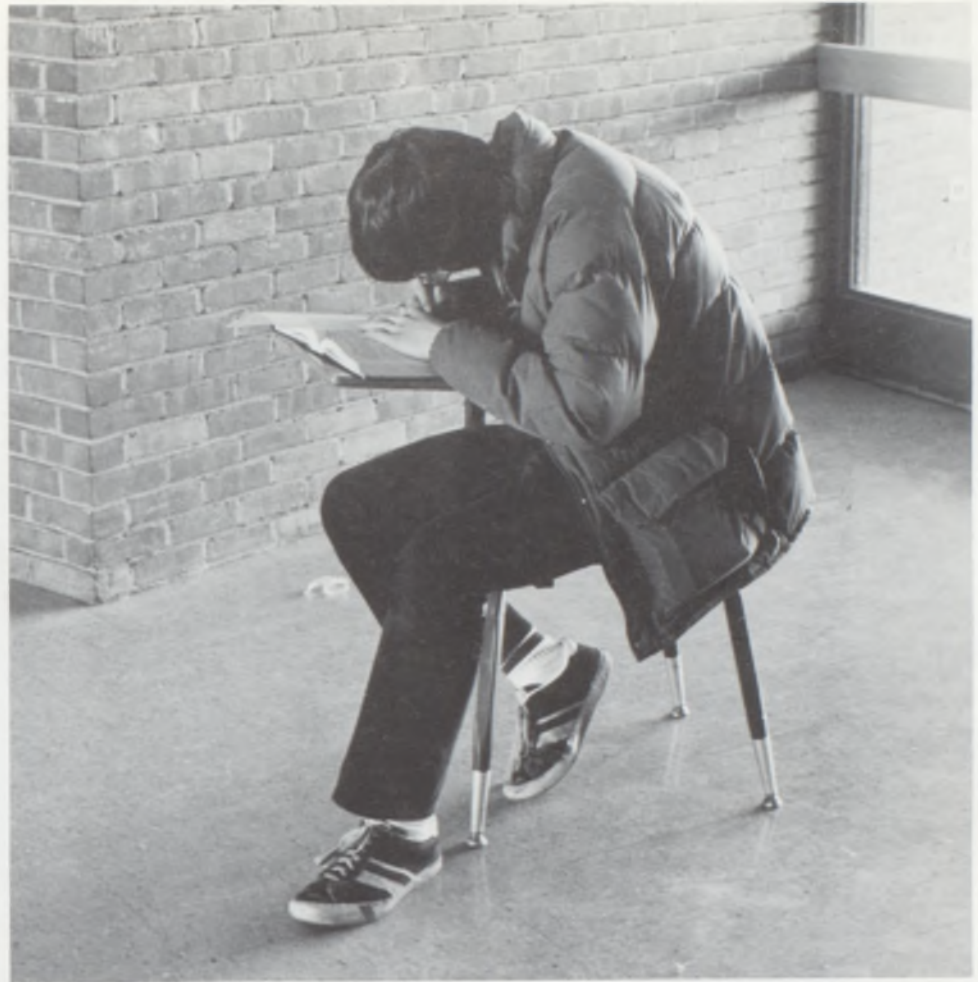
But Oh Those Deerfield Nights

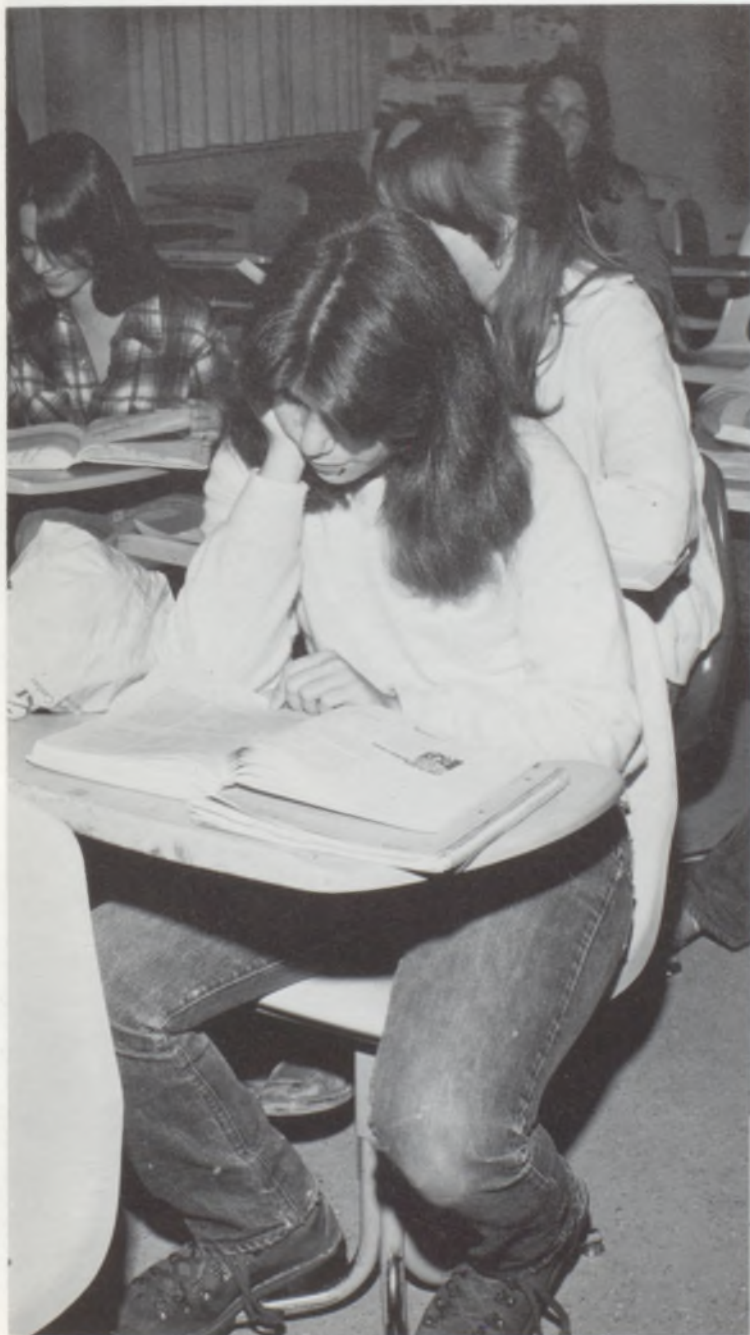


Foreign Languages

Science

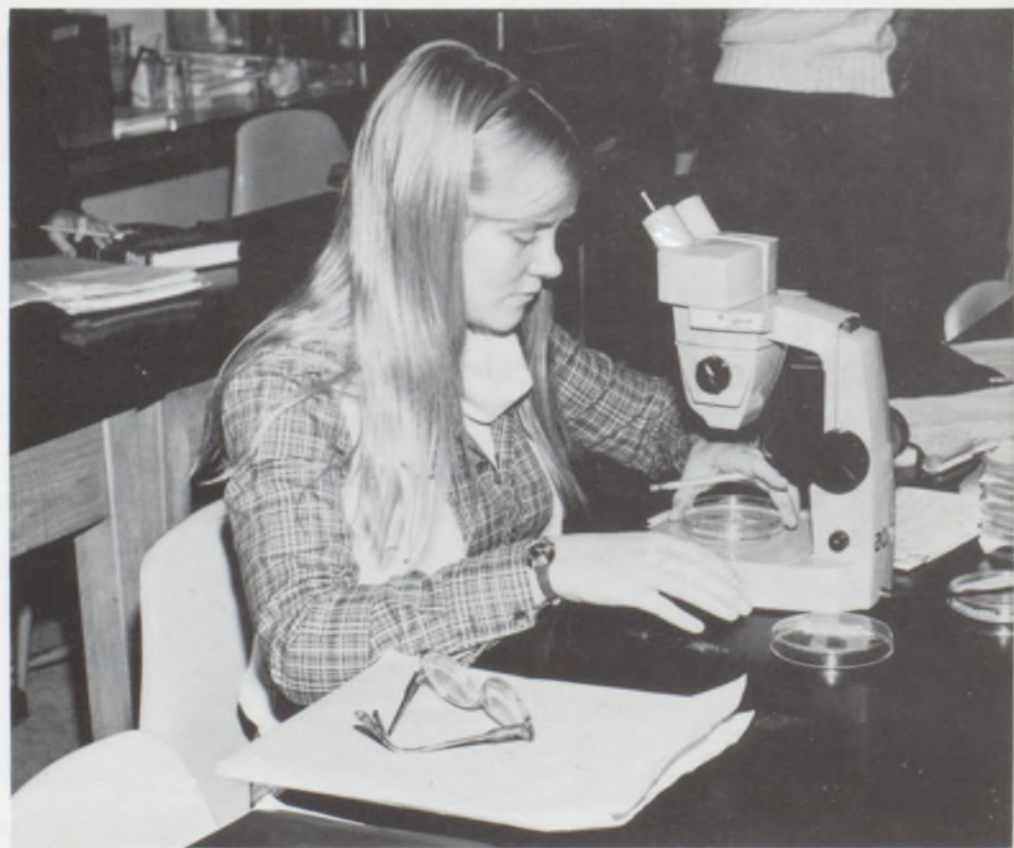

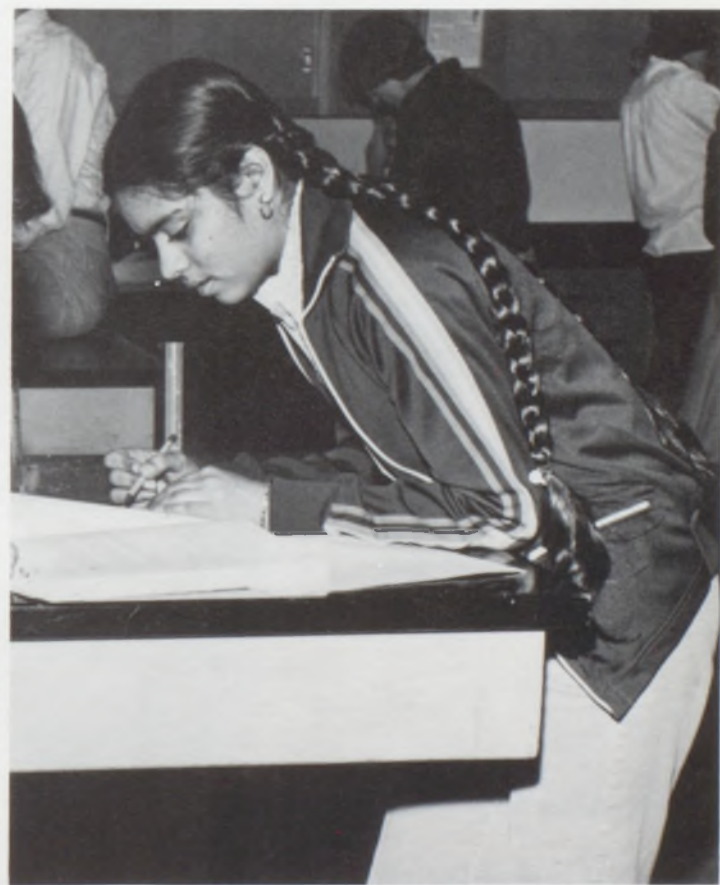

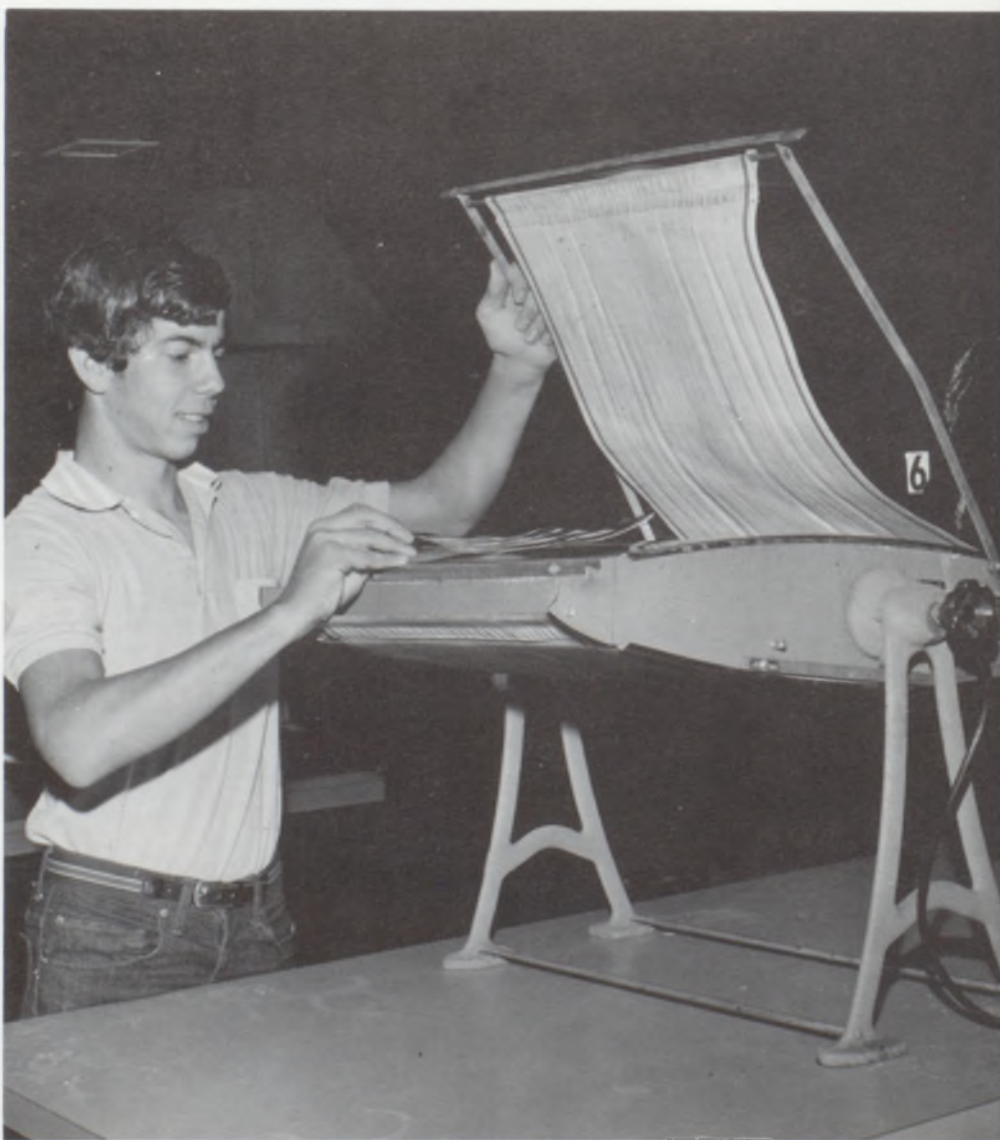

Fine Arts

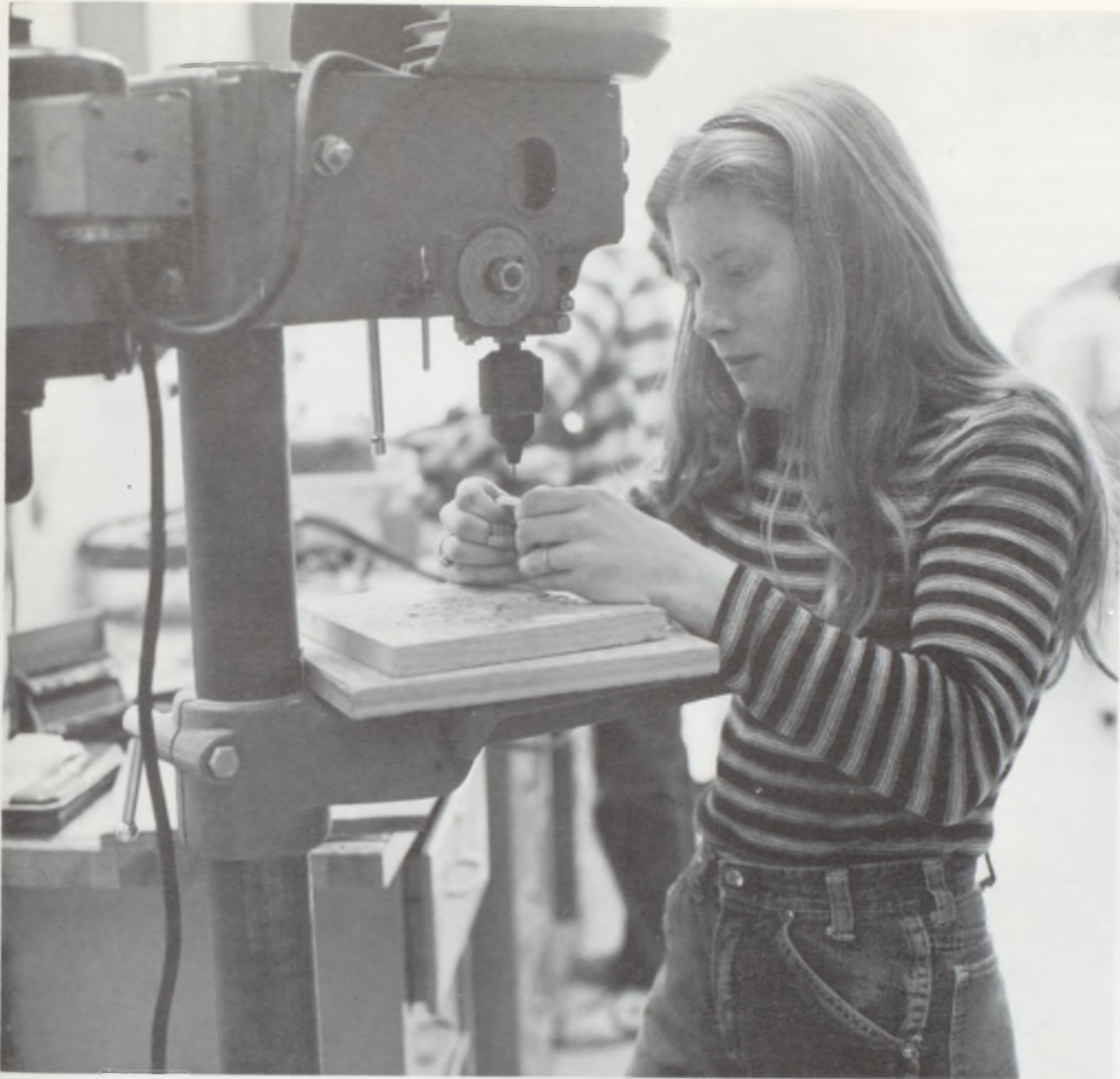

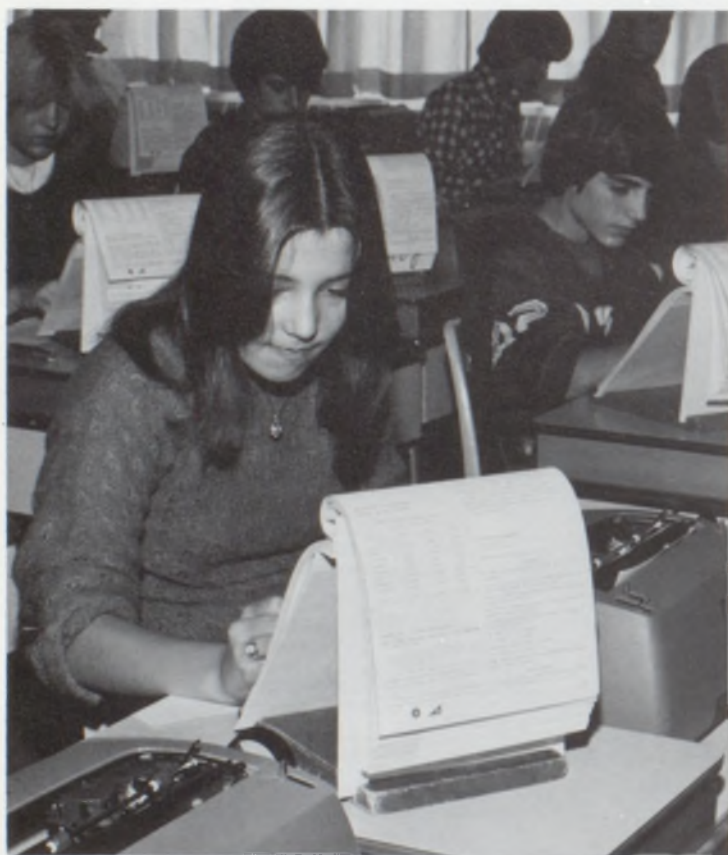

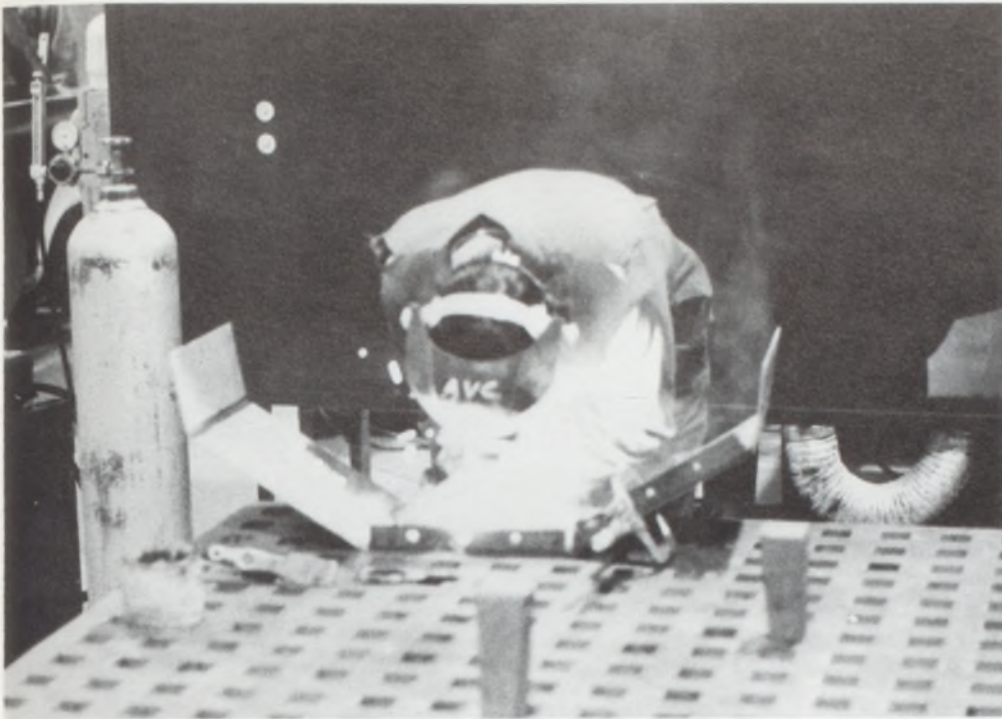

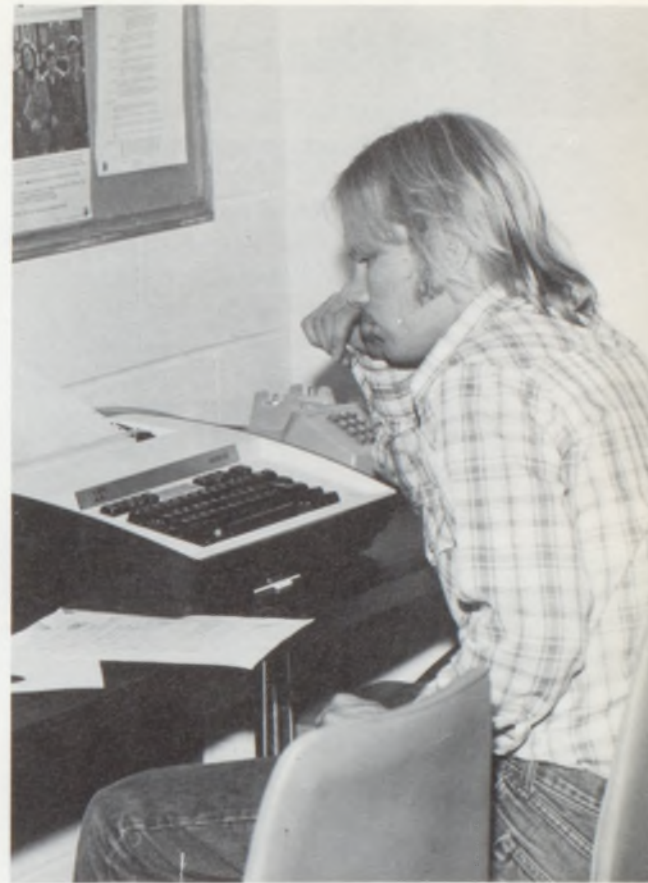

Indians Scalp State Hopes

Finishing the season with an 8-1 record, the Warriors battled their way to co-championship of the Central Suburban League North Division, sharing the berth with New Trier East. The East Indians upset Deerfield on Homecoming to give them their only loss. DHS then came back to win its remaining games, defeating Evanston, New Trier West, and a much improved Waukegan West. The fighting Warriors also defeated rival Highland Park and Niles North by sizeable scores. Although they failed to make the state playoffs, DHS did produce two all-state players, back Brian Collins and fullback John Sweeney. Sweeney broke Dave Percak's rushing record set in 1975 by accumulating 1,035 yards. The football Warriors had a strong season and were enthusiastically backed by all of Deerfield.

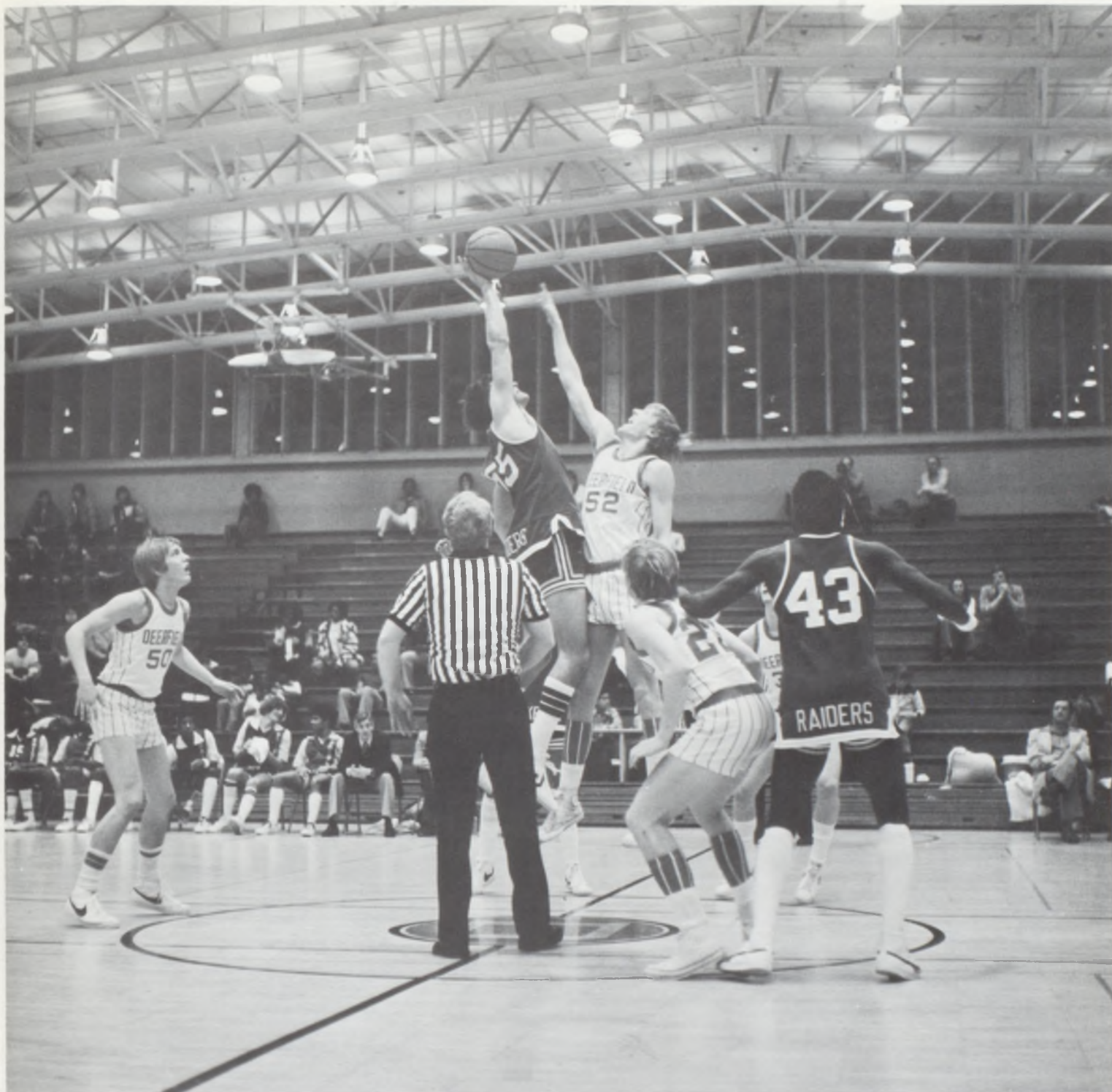

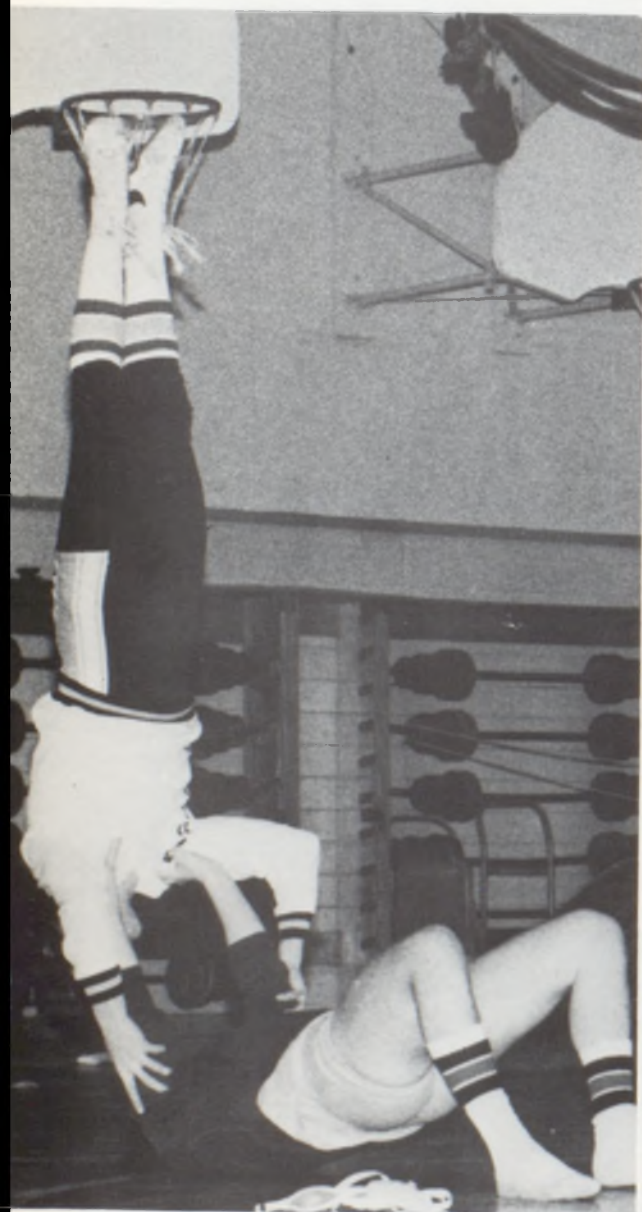
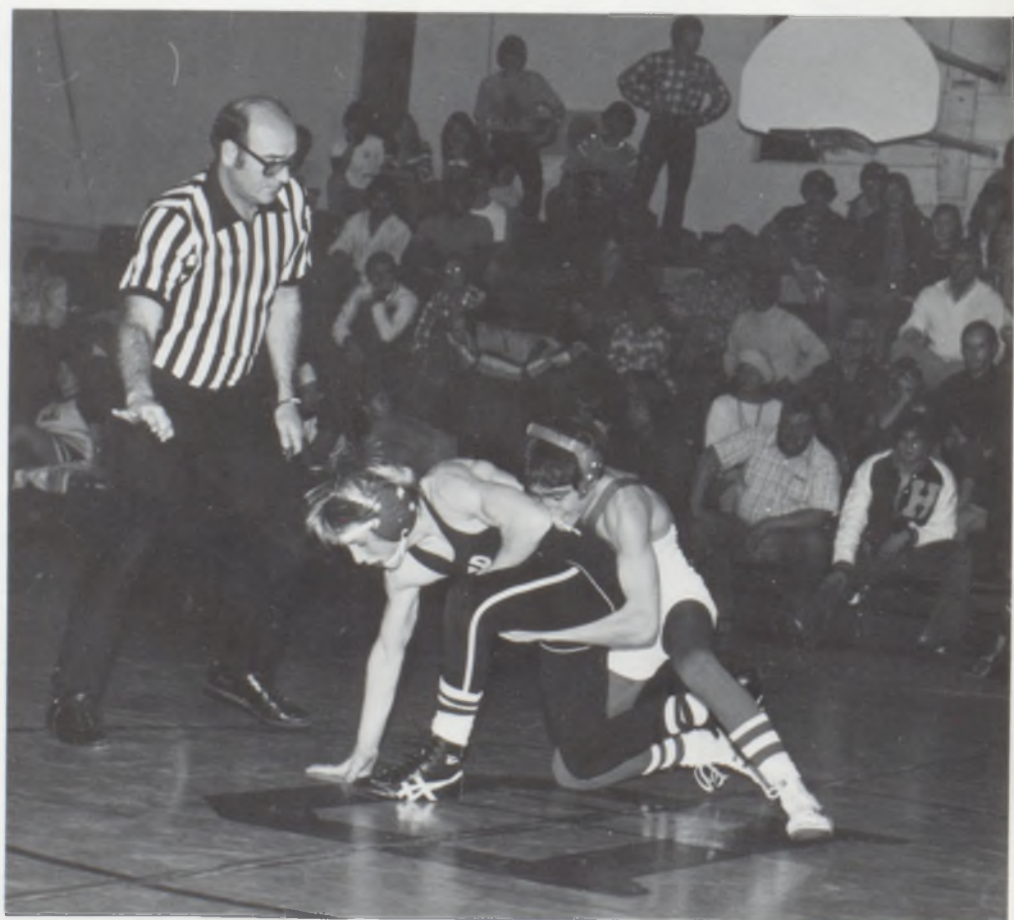


Vacant Weights — Gloomy Fate

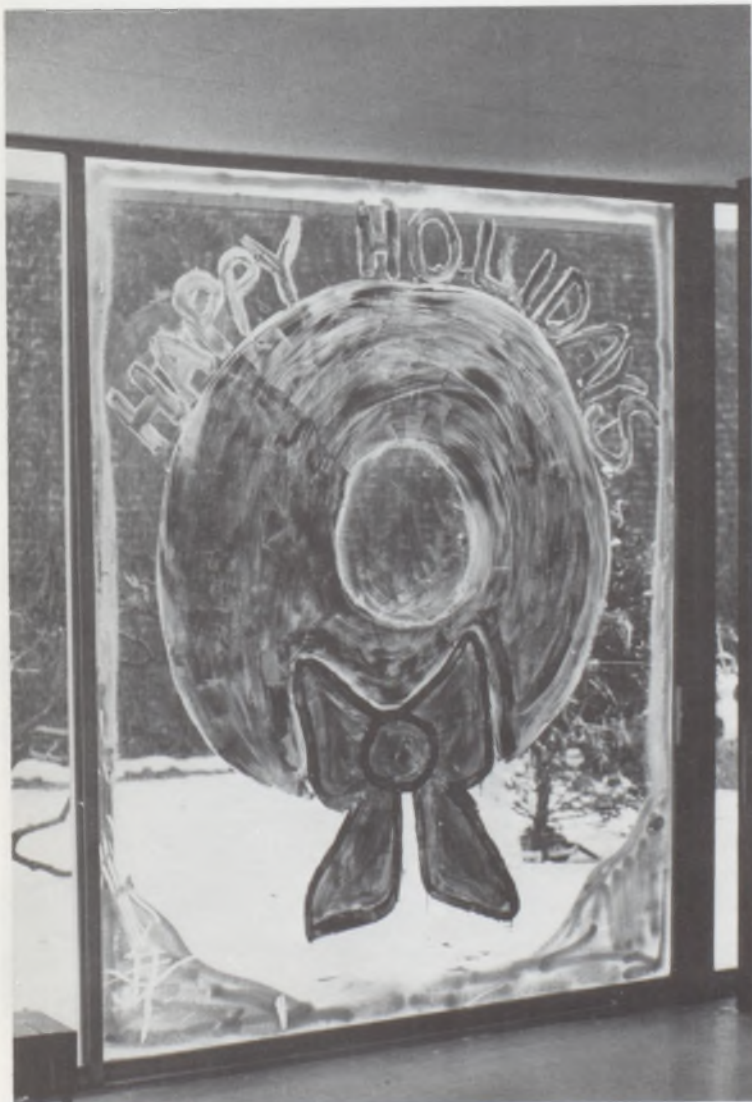
