She's the Fine Arts department chair and dance teacher in school, but outside DHS, Andrea Johnson participates in a couple of different organizations that she calls her "after school activities." Along with teaching dance in school, Johnson is the Director of
 Training programs for Deeply Rooted; a Chicago based professional dance company. She organizes classes, runs auditions, and creates programs of both the professional and non professional sort. She *also runs an intense four week summer program to keep all the dancers up to date and in shape. Another program Andrea is currently involved in is the African American Families Jack and Jill Association. It's an organization created for African American parents and their children (from ages two to eighteen) to participate in different activities such as service projects and small plays for different communities. She says, "It's a good way for people
cFollow the things you are passsionate about:" to come together, connect with each other, and have a good time. It also helps families spend more quality time together." After all that, Johnson comes home to a very busy household. She has three kids, two sons and one daughter, a husband, and two dogs. Although things get crazy and hectic sometimes, she says, "Without one of these things I wouldn't be who I am." Some of her other hobbies include cooking, watching movies (her ultimate favorite is the Shawshank Redemption), and reading fiction books written by African American women. She loves what she does and always encourages students to "follow the things that you are passionate about and don't worry about the outcome because it will always be good."

## M Mile it may seem surprising that Chuck Wathen used to be a monk, <br> after talking to him for a while, it starts to make a lot of sense. After all, Wathen's whole demeanor exudes a calm-

 ness that makes him seem like a Buddha - whether he's describing math as the language of spheres, life as the calculus of infinitesimals, or finding fascination in the patterns and relationships evident in math and music, Wathen peppers his language with spiritual and cosmic analogies. But don't mistake him for a new age type - Wathen's interests are more than superficial. Take for instance the time he spent as a Christian brother. For six years, Wathen was on a path toward taking final vows as a monk. Wathen describes the lifestyle as a "simple, quiet life. Men living together for a common good." And although the experience was an important one, Wathen decided against taking the final vows. Today he still believes himself to be a deeply spiritual person, but that spirituality speaks to him more in the form of Buddhism these days. It is not surprising then; the way Wathen describes another passion, running, as a mind-body link that gives him a life's perspective. When running, Wathen says he forgoes the discman - forcing him to listen to the world around him. He believes that running is mostly a mental exercise - the mind simply another organ of the body - how one treats each, affects the other. His method must be working because Wathen is still pretty fast for his age - for
any age logging 2000 miles a year and placing "This may sound bad, in runs around the country. Wathen's belief in relationships and patterns could be a good explanation for why this mathematician is also such a talented pianist, although he admits that his piano playing has tapered off in recent years as but it doesn't really matter what you do in the classroom."
his family life has grown. Wathen and his wife, a family physician, have a 5 year old son Lucas, and $11 / 2$ year old daughter, Lily. Wathen calls their life "abundantly full," and his priority making time. He believes in teaching by example, living your beliefs rather than talking about them - Wathen was inspired by a story about Ghandi who didn't speak every 7th day, no matter what. Caught in a crowd of people on one such day, they begged him for a direction, a message. He says that Ghandi leaned over to an advisor to whisper an answer "Tell them my life is my message." Wathen uses this story to illustrate a point - "lf you are going to do something, just do it" he says, "If you're going to start doing yoga, don't talk about how you do yoga or how much you do yoga, just do it and get really good at it. This may sound bad, but it doesn't really matter what you do in the classroom, it's how you live your life that counts."

Lee Weisman may seem like the average Spanish teacher but in fact, Weisman's method of connecting the "real world" to her curriculum makes what she does in the classroom so intriguing. For example, Weisman started a program where her students travel to Oak Terrace Elementary School in Highwood every week to tutor kids in both English and Spanish. Since Oak Terrace has a large population of Hispanic Students, most of whom learned Spanish as their first language, the DHS students improve their Spanish while helping the children improve their English. Weisman says, "The program gives my students a better understanding of what it is like to be Mexican and come to America. They get a bit of history while improving their Spanish skills." Lee has since received a federal grant of over $\$ 120,000$ to expand this program and create more service based programs in the future. She would like to establish a program in which the students work with Hispanic seniors in a nursing home and get to learn about their culture and language from the patients themselves. She also hopes to run fundraisers in the future to help different worthy causes as well as Oak Terrace elementary. Another program that Senora Weisman began in her own classroom is called Tarea Tremenda. This program requires her students to go out and do something culturally related each quarter and report back on it. Many students visit Hispanic restaurants or learn to salsa dance as a way of exploring the culture. Other students choose to interview a person from a

 like. With all these wonderful programs going on it is hard for Lee to not bring home her work. She has three kids, all of whom speak Spanish, who support her in all that she does. She states, "Things will get tough but you have to remember that when life gives you lemons make lemonade. Make the best of every situation."

Since then, Rockaitis has spent numerous Saturdays sorting, cleaning, and packing shoes in the Share Your Soles warehouse. These serendipitous twists and turns in his life
